

ENROLLMENT REQUIREMENTS

The Graduate School requires graduate students must enroll in a minimum number of credits to be considered full-time. The Math Department's minimum is 6 credits each semester, except in summer and except for dissertators.

The minimum number of credits depends largely on your funding status.

If you have an RA or have a Fellowship (domestic and international students):

Non-dissertators:

Fall or Spring semesters, at least 8 graduate credits for a grade (not pass/fail or audit)

Summer semester, at least 2 graduate credits during the general eight-week session for a grade (not pass/fail or audit)

Dissertators:

Fall / Spring / Summer semesters, you need to register for **exactly** 3 credits for a grade (not pass/fail or audit)

If you have a TA or a PA (domestic and international students):

Non-dissertators:

Fall or Spring semesters:

33% appointment – at least 6 graduate credits for a grade (not pass/fail or audit)

50% appointment – at least 4 graduate credits for a grade (not pass/fail or audit)

Summer semester, Graduate School does **not** require enrollment, but departments or employing office may

Dissertators:

Fall or Spring semesters, you need to register for exactly 3 credits for a grade (not pass/fail or audit)

Summer semester, Graduate School does **not** require enrollment **UNLESS** you are **graduating** during the summer, then you must enroll in 3 credits.

Note: If you are involved with various departments requiring minimum enrollments, you should follow the rules of the department that requires the most..
